

Roadworks are starting in your area soon.

What's happening, where and when?

We will be undertaking strengthening and repair works to the culvert.

Where: Welsh Road, Edgcote (Trafford Bridge)

When: 8th July – 30th August

Times: Working hours 08:00 – 16:30

How long: 8 weeks

Traffic Management: A 24/7 Road closure with an approved diversion route will be in place. Please see plan showing the road closure extents in red and the diversion route in blue.

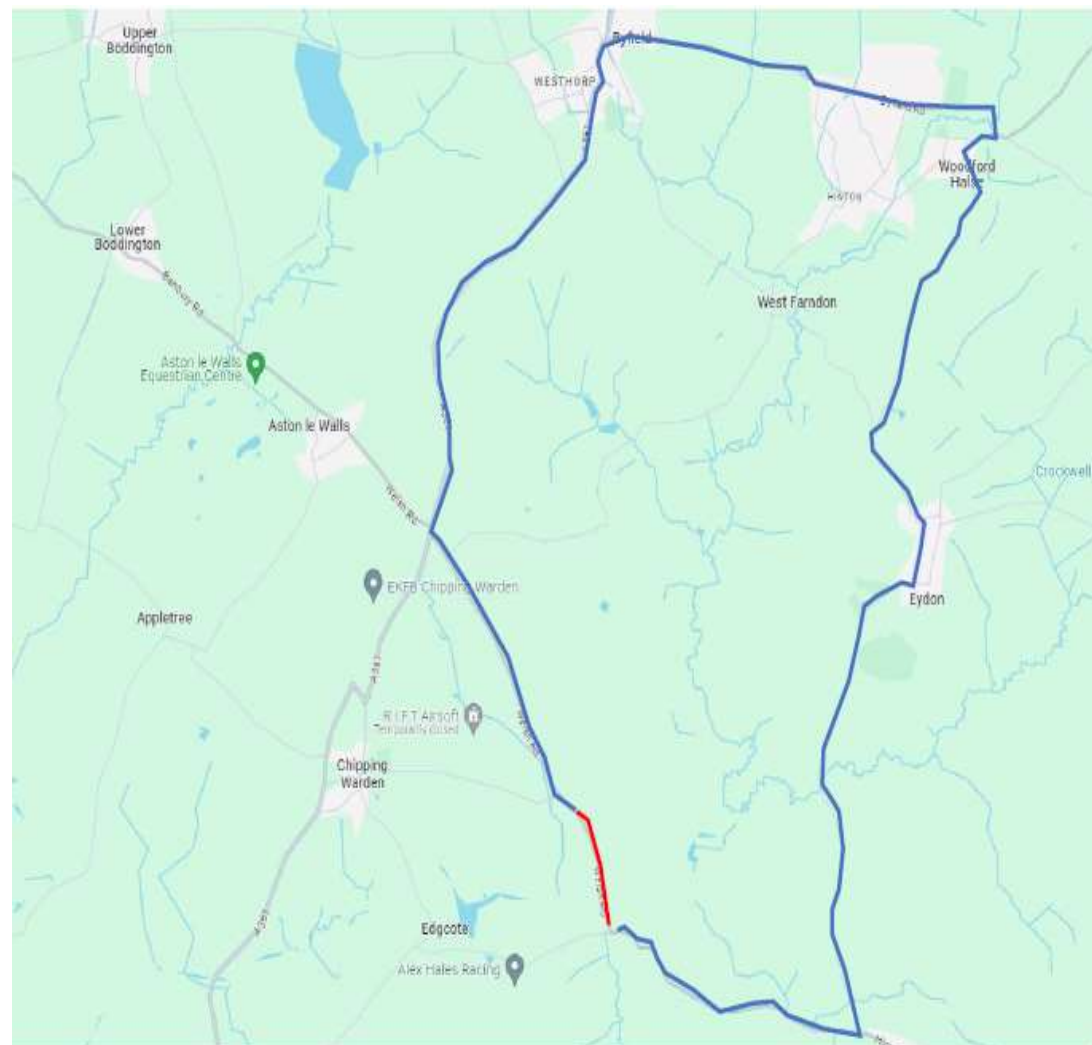
Access: There will be a through route during the works.

Emergency Vehicles: We aim to maintain access for emergency vehicles where safe to do so.

Pedestrians and Cyclists: Cyclists will be asked to follow the diversion route. Alternatively, cyclists can dismount their bike and walk on the footway. The footway will be open for pedestrians.

Public Transport: No bus stops will be affected.

Please see below the road closure highlighted in **RED**, and approved diversion highlighted in **BLUE**.






Parking and Property/Business Access

We must ask that vehicles are not parked on the road within the works area during the road closure periods. We also recommend you plan extra time for your journeys.

We hope this information is helpful and we apologise for any inconvenience these essential works may cause. We will make every effort to minimise any unnecessary disruption. Our team on site will be ready to assist you with any issues you may have during the work, and we hope you will find our employees courteous and helpful.
