Who can apply?

You can apply for a grant for educational expenses if you are under 25, and you, or your parents live in Eydon. You may be at school, or in further education or training.

If you have any queries before applying, contact one of the Trustees. Who you are, what you discuss, apply for and are awarded, is kept confidential.

When is the closing date for applications?

The closing date for applications is 31st October. The outcome of applications and the amount of any grant awarded are made after the closing date.

Below are the facts needed by the Trustees but they welcome a covering letter or email from students in their own words about the studies or training.
