Banbury Lane, Thorpe Mandeville.

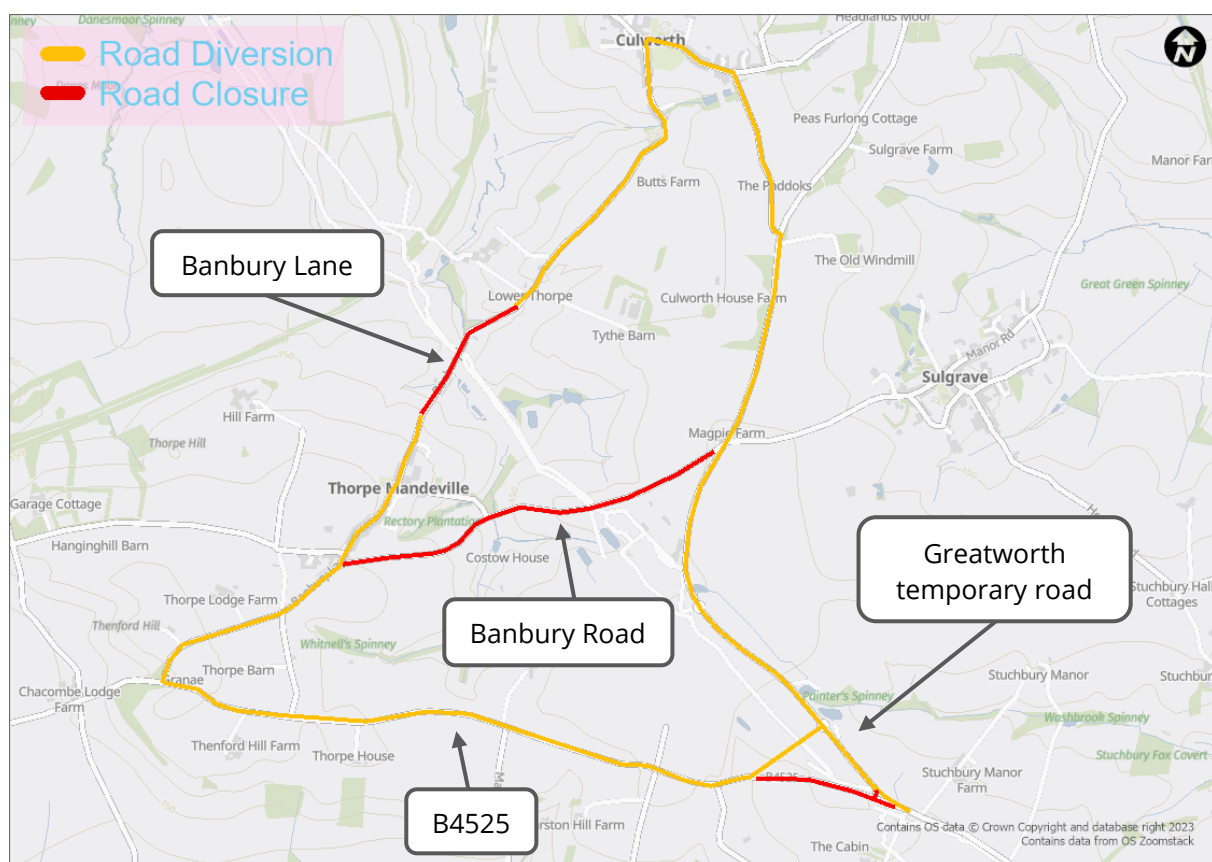

## Additional information

Between Thorpe Mandeville and Culworth we have been building the Lower Thorpe viaduct. Earlier this summer, the Lower Thorpe viaduct was launched over Banbury Lane. We are now progressing with the concrete works for the deck structure.

We have erected a travelling platform that will move from the southern end of the viaduct, northwards as the deck concreting work progresses along the viaduct. Whilst we complete these activities above the road, to ensure the safety of road users, short closures of Banbury Lane are required.

A signed diversion will be in place using the Greatworth Temporary Road, as shown in the map below.
